WAIVER FOR PLAYER & VOLUNTEERS

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

1. IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in any Fuquay Varina Athletic Association activity, I and/or my minor child, our personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin:
2. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I and/or my minor understand the nature of Fuquay-Varina Athletic Association and that I and/or my minor child are qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I further agree that if at any time I believe conditions or equipment to be unsafe, I and /or my minor child will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.
3. FULLY UNDERSTAND that: (a) FUQUAY VARINA ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by me and/or my child's own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; there may be OTHER RISKS AND SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I and/or my minor child incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.
4. HEREBY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, AND ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE LOSSES, COSTS, AND/OR DAMAGES FOLLOWING SUCH INJURY, DISABILITY, PARALYSIS, OR DEATH, EVEN IF CAUSED, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW;
5. HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE FUQUAY-VARINA ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, their respective member teams and leagues, their administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, team members and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place, (each considered one of the "RELEASEES" herein) FROM ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ON MY ACCOUNT CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE RESCUE OPERATIONS; AND I FURTHER AGREE that if, despite this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT I and/or my minor child, or anyone on my and/or my minor child's behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS EACH OF THE RELEASEES from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as the result of such claim.
6. I HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT OR ASSURANCE OF ANY NATURE AND INTEND IT TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW AND AGREE THAT IF ANY PORTION OF THIS AGREEMENT IS HELD TO BE INVALID THE BALANCE, NOTWITHSTANDING, SHALL CONTINUE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

"Leadership, Sportsmanship, and Teamwork through Athletics"

PARENTS ARE REQUIRED TO READ, THEN SIGN AND DATE THIS AGREEMENT.

1. I understand that the FVAA is organized to promote youth athletics and good sportsmanship.
2. I understand that my conduct as a parent will have a definite impact on the youth for whom it is intended, the program, and myself.
3. I pledge to support, cooperate, and work in every way to promote youth athletics in the best interest of the programs and youths involved.
4. I pledge to be respectful to all officials, even in an expression of disagreement.
5. I do agree to adhere to the principles of good sportsmanship and to the rules and regulations defined by the FVAA & all other sport affiliations.
6. I understand that if I display poor sportsmanship, whether during or following a game, I will be subject to partial or permanent program suspension. Unsportsmanlike conduct is defined as, but not limited to the following:
 - a. harassment of participants or officials
 - b. use of profane language and / or gestures
 - c. public threats or physical violence
7. Regulations regarding adult's ejection or suspension will follow the guidelines listed below:
 - a. I understand that if I am asked to leave a game, I will be suspended from attending the next game to be played by my son's / daughter's team.
 - b. I understand that if I am asked to leave a second game during any one season, I will not be allowed to attend all the remaining regular season games and the end of season tournament activities.
 - c. I understand that if I am found under the influence of alcohol or drugs while at a FVAA function, I will not be allowed to attend any preseason activities, all regular season activities, and all end-of-season activities that my son's / daughter's team may be involved in. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on FVAA facilities.
 - d. I understand that the FVAA Board will review all adult ejections or suspension and may extend any suspension beyond what is stated above as deemed appropriate for the offense.
8. I agree that I will support the FVAA regular and post-season All Tournament team coaches' selection process, and I will not participate in, nor encourage any All Tournament player to play on an alternative team unless given prior approval by the FVAA Board. This item does not apply to travel tournament teams.
9. I will not participate in the purchase of uniforms or parts thereof and accept the uniform issued and used by the FVAA. I may, however, purchase white baseball pants, gray softball pants, gray softball shorts, striped baseball socks, cheerleading kick pants, cheerleading competition shoes, soccer shorts and soccer socks. Player's names are not to be added to the back of the game jerseys before or during the playing season. **This item does not apply to travel tournament teams.**
10. I understand that **any** suspension may be appealed by using the following process. The suspended individual (parents, guardians of a player) should submit in writing a detailed account of the incident to the appropriate league commissioner within 48 hours of the incident. The statement should give names of any witnesses that observed the incident. The league commissioner then will perform a preliminary investigation and make a recommendation to the appropriate athletic commission.

I UNDERSTAND THAT FAILURE TO ABIDE BY ALL ITEMS ABOVE COULD RESULT IN SUSPENSION OR DISMISSAL FROM THE FVAA.

Youth Basketball
Registration**

Registration for all divisions of the FVAA's 2011-2012 Youth Basketball League will continue through the **deadline of Friday, October 14, 2011.**

All new participants must furnish a copy of their birth certificates at the time of registration.

To register, participants need to complete the registration form, have one of their parents or guardians sign the liability waiver on the form, and submit with the **\$65.00 registration fee, if faxing please call to confirm receipt.** Please make check or money order payable to the FVAA or indicate credit card information on registration form. The FVAA Board of Directors has implemented a \$10.00 late fee for all registrations received after the deadline.

Remember: ALL REGISTRANTS AND COACHES MUST BE CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE FVAA. PLEASE BE SURE TO RENEW YOUR MEMBERSHIP, OR JOIN THE FVAA WHEN REGISTERING.

Any participants who intend to try-out for the Middle School or High School basketball team **must also** register by the deadline. Fees will be refunded to those who are selected to their school team and **wish not to play** with the FVAA. Written notification must be given to the FVAA Office for participants playing with their school teams and dropping FVAA basketball.

Players not registered by the October 14, 2011 deadline will be ineligible for the league drafts. ANY late registrants, including returning players, will be assigned to a waiting list and unless an opening is available, will not be allowed to participate this season.

IMPORTANT INSURANCE INFORMATION

FVAA member participants, coaches, officials, and volunteers are covered by general liability and accident insurance during each sport season at all practices and games scheduled by the FVAA.

LEAGUES / AGES

Pacific League will consist of boys and girls who are 6 by October 15, 2011 and no older than 7 on October 15, 2011.

Atlantic League will consist of boys and girls who are 7 by October 15, 2011 and no older than 8 on October 15, 2011.

Junior Girls will consist of GIRLS who are 9 by October 15, 2011 and no older than 10 on October 15, 2011.

Intermediate Girls will consist of GIRLS who are 11 by October 15, 2011 and no older than 12 on October 15, 2011.

**** Prep Girls** will consist of GIRLS who are 13 by October 15, 2011 and no older than 15 on October 15, 2011.

****Important Note:** The above-proposed formation of the girls' leagues by age breakdown is dependent upon the number of registrants. If necessary, fewer leagues will be formed with a wider age span in order to allow all ages to participate.

Junior Boys will consist of BOYS who are 9 by October 15, 2011 and no older than 10 on October 15, 2011.

Intermediate Boys will consist of BOYS who are 11 by October 15, 2011 and no older than 12 on October 15, 2011.

Prep Boys will consist of BOYS who are 13 by October 15, 2011 and no older than 14 on October 15, 2011.

Senior Boys will consist of BOYS who are 15 by October 15, 2011 and no older than 16 on October 15, 2011.

If a parent wishes a participant to play in a league, either above or below the league stipulated by the birth dates or grades, a written request must be made with the registration form stating the reason. The Basketball Sports Committee will make the determination, and you will be notified of their decision prior to the drafts. Also if you do NOT wish for your child to play for a certain coach, this request MUST be in writing with a brief explanation prior to league drafts.

TEAM PRACTICE / GAMES

Team practices will begin around late November. The regular season games are scheduled to begin Monday, December 5, 2011. Practices will be held in Fuquay Varina. The tournament championship games at the end of the season are **tentatively** scheduled for the first week of March 2012.

MANDATORY LEAGUE EVALUATIONS

The MANDATORY evaluations for all players will be held on the following dates and times at the Community Center Gym located at 820 S. Main Street. If your player can NOT attend one of the MANDATORY evaluations, you MUST send a written notification, attached to registration form or email fvaa@nc.rr.com by Tuesday, November 1st.

Pacific Leagues (6 yr olds) will NOT have an evaluation. Players will be selected and placed on teams by the Basketball Committee.

Eligible players MUST be present for the evaluation so that the coaches may evaluate their ability and level of skill.

REFUND POLICY

The \$65.00 registration fee less the \$15.00 service charge is refundable for all participants only by written request received by the FVAA on or before Monday, November 14, 2011. (Those accepted for a school team and not wishing to play FVAA Basketball will receive a full refund if dropped before league draft. Please email fvaa@nc.rr.com to inform them of your school participation instead of FVAA participation.)

UNIFORMS

The \$65.00 registration fee per participant helps to cover the cost of equipment, uniforms, and referees for the games. The FVAA will provide a uniform T-shirt to each participant. Any participant who chooses to wear undergarments that are visible must adhere to the following: **Undergarment bottoms must be the same color as the regulation jersey or shorts. Game shorts must be either white or black or the same color as the team jersey and EVERYONE on the team must wear the same color of shorts.**

TROPHY POLICY

The FVAA will purchase and award participation trophies to the Pacific and Atlantic league only. The FVAA will purchase and award individual championship trophies to each player on the team winning the regular season and / or tournament championships of the Pacific, Atlantic, Junior, Intermediate, Prep, Senior, Junior Girls, Intermediate Girls, and Prep Girls Basketball leagues. However, the members of the regular season or tournament championship team will receive only one trophy at the FVAA expense. If a team wins both the regular season and tournament championship, the players for that team will receive only one trophy each, reflecting both championships on the engraved plate of the trophy.
