2008 FVAA Fall T-Ball

REGISTRATION

Registration for FVAA Fall T-Ball League will begin on Monday, June 9, 2008, and continue through the deadline of **Friday, July 18, 2008**. All new FVAA participants **must** furnish a copy of their birth certificate at the time of registration.

To register, participants need to complete the 2008 Fall T-Ball Registration form, have one of their parents or guardians sign the liability waiver on the form, and submit them by the deadline with the \$65.00 registration fee (please make check or money order payable to the FVAA or indicate credit card information on registration form). **Remember: All registrants and coaches must be current members of the FVAA, please be sure to renew your membership, or join the FVAA when registering.**

Any player not registered by the **July 18, 2008** deadline will be assigned to a waiting list and unless an opening is available, will not be allowed to participate this season. A \$10.00 late fee will apply for all applications received after the deadline.

IMPORTANT INSURANCE INFORMATION

FVAA member participants, coaches, officials, and volunteers are covered by general liability and accident insurance during each sport season at all practices and games scheduled by the FVAA.

LEAGUES / AGES

The 2008 Fall T-Ball League age cut-off date to determine league eligibility is **April 30, 2008**. YES, April 30 is a new age cutoff date.

In case of inclement weather, please check the field condition hotline: 552-5465 x21 or check the website- fvaa.org for cancellation of practices or games. The information on the phone and the web is usually updated by 4:00 p.m. on weekdays or 7:00 a.m. on weekends.

PRACTICE / GAMES

Practice is scheduled to begin around the middle of August. Practice will be held in Fuquay-Varina in the evenings and weekends. Usually the t-ball teams are scheduled for two activities a week which might be one practice during the week and a game on the weekend.

Games will start the week after Labor Day and will be played in the evenings and Saturday mornings until late October.

UNIFORMS / EQUIPMENT

The \$65.00 registration fee per participant helps to cover the cost of equipment and uniforms. All players must furnish their own **baseball glove, white baseball pants and shoes**. Players' names are not to be added to the back of the game jerseys before or during the season. The FVAA will provide necessary equipment, such as bats, balls, catchers' equipment, etc. A game jersey and cap will be issued to each participant and will be kept by the player at the conclusion of the season.

REFUND POLICY

The \$65.00 registration fee less the \$15.00 service charge is refundable only by written request received at the FVAA Office on or before Monday, August 4, 2008.

TROPHY POLICY

Under its current policy, the FVAA will purchase and award participation trophies to each player.
